In literacy we have started reading our new novel, 'Breadwinner' by Deborah Ellis. This story follows the hardships of a young girl living in Afghanistan under Taliban

rule. Through it, we will explore the themes of bravery, friendship and courage.

In maths this term we are revising previously taught concepts as well as working with decimals up to 3 decimal places, exploring negative numbers and moving on to calculations with negative numbers, time calculations and durations and properties of shapes including different types of triangles and circles.

With it being a new school year, we have revisited the UNCRC and revised our rights and how they apply to all of us, always. We have also explored how this links to Pope Francis letter Laudato Si and how we must care for our Common Home. We have begun to create a class charter that reflects the UNCRC articles which are important to us in school along with the principles of Laudato Si.'
