### Literacy

The literacy programme will continue on from P1. For the first few weeks, we will be doing weekly revision of phonemes and common words, before the P2 programme starts. The children will continue to have an assessment on a Friday, which will focus on the weekly literacy

work. The children will also continue to read the Engage Reading books, which will be sent home on a Monday and should be returned on a Friday. It would be really appreciated if you could ensure your child's book is returned on a Friday as other children in school may also need to use them. The children will continue to have a word box with the weekly common words. If possible, please take some time to revise these words with your child; they can be written out, revised orally or any way you have time to support. Every little bit completed at home supports our classroom learning. As part of the P2 classroom routine, the children will have daily targets to complete, as well as teacher led lessons and activities. These activities may be within the classroom or in the open area, which the children also had access to in Primary 1.

In Numeracy, we will be concentrating on revision for the first few weeks. Our focus will be our number stories to aid us in addition and subtraction, sequencing and ordering of numbers, missing numbers on a number line and on a 100 square. In mental maths, we will be investigating strategies to help us look for patterns in numbers and how maths can be found in the environment.

Last Friday, we celebrated our first school Mass with Fr Alex, for the Feast of The Assumption.

In our Health & Wellbeing programme there will be a focus on learning about building positive friendships and ways we can all work together to make our class special. We will also work together to create our class promise.
