also be exposed to a range of activities that will support their fine motor skills and correct formation of each single sound.

This can be supported at home by completing the homework worksheets, word tubs and Seesaw tasks.

#### **Numeracy**

In numeracy we will have a big focus on numbers to 10. We will look at these numbers using, numicon, ten frames, dice and a range of concrete materials. We will also focus on the number bonds for each number to help support addition and subtraction within 10. Along-side the number work, we will also be looking at time over the next few weeks. We

will begin to look the days of the week, o'clock and digital and analogue clocks.

Again, numeracy work can be supported at home by completing the Seesaw homework tasks.

#### <u>P.E</u>

During the week, Primary 1 will have two PE slots. Indoor P.E will be on Tuesday afternoons and outdoor P.E will be on Friday. On these two days, children should come into school dressed in their P.E kits.
