Spelling

- Primary 1 will complete 2 sound each week up until Christmas.
- Sound 1 is taught on Monday, common words taught on Tuesday and sound 2 will be taught on Wednesday.
- We will use the magnetic boards, formation sheets and a range of fine motor/creative tasks to reinforce this.

Reading

- The children will all get a new reading book each week. The previous weeks reading book will be sent home as homework to reinforce common words and sounds covered.
- We will begin to practise reading strategies such as predicting, using picture clues and sounding out unfamiliar words.

Writing

- Primary 1 will be focusing on their fine motor skills and technical targets to support their writing.
- We will be looking at capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and beginning to form some letters independently.

Numeracy

- We will be looking at a range of number outcomes alongside beyond number.
- The children will complete a range of teaching table tasks, targets and play based activities to reinforce learning.

Homework

- Homework will be communicated on Seesaw.
- Spelling homework will follow the same routine as in class (Sound 1 available on Monday, common words available on Tuesday and sound 2 will be available on Wednesday).
- Word tubs and reading books should be returned on Friday of each week to allow turn around time for the next week. Thank you.
